## Acrylic Supply List

All supplies can be bought at United Art and Education. They are very helpful and will assist you if they have any questions.

Paints may be purchased in tubes or bottles. All paint must say acrylic.

If buying bottles, Handy Art is an acceptable brand and gives more product for the money. Color names in Handy Art are:

1. *Bright Red,*
2. *Pthalo Blue or Cobalt Blue*
3. *Pthalo Green*
4. *Chrome Yellow*
5. *Mars Black*
6. *Titanium White*

If buying tubes, the color names are:

1. *Cad. Red Medium*
2. *Ivory Black*
3. *Cadmium Yellow Medium*
4. *Cobalt Blue*
5. *Titanium White* (if students are sharing, two tubes of white are required)
6. *Pthalo Green*

An inexpensive grade of paint is fine for beginners.

One tube of acrylic gel medium. This retards drying time. In different brands this may be called: retarder, gel medium, or extender.

Four stretched canvasses, or one pad of canvasette. Canvasette looks like a notepad of plastic canvas sheets. The student can choose the size they prefer, no smaller than 9x12 and no larger than 12x16.

One each of the following brushes\knives:

1. Number 2- size flat Taklon - Red handle with soft short white bristles.
2. Number 8-size flat Taklon - Red handle with soft long white bristles.
3. Number 2 size fan brush - Rough bristles in the shape of a fan.
4. Number 0 size liner brush - Shorter bristles preferable.
5. One-inch hardware brush - practical for any painting needs (interior painting, etc.)
6. Plastic or metal palette knife - with the knife end having a long, slender style, avoid the short more triangular style.
